- 1. Books that are one hundred years-old teach a more "do it yourself" approach to gardening. "Back on the farm," folks had to be more self reliant, less dependent on local farm stores, farm coops, and feed stores.
- 2. Garden tools were simpler. Easier to repair. No gas powered tools. No gas rotor tiller or well pump.
- 3. Some tools that we no longer use could be very useful today. We should bring them back, for example, the "wheel hoe."
- 4. The old ways were more naturally organic. Old methods of fighting pests were naturally more organic then spraying modern chemicals.
- 5. Fertilizer was barnyard manure instead of chemicals. It was an art to prepare and apply animal manure.
- 6. Old folks valued and brewed green manure. What is that? How is it made.
- 7. Back then, they relied more on hothouses and cold frames. To extend the growing season. How? What are they used for?
- 8. Old timers possessed a fanatical attachment to heirloom seeds. What are heirloom seeds? Which ones? Why?

- 9. A century ago folks grew food on window sills in their houses. How much food? How did they do that?
- 10. Gardening was more of a family effort and a community effort.
- 11. Growing food back then was a life-or-death proposition. No garden in the summer. No food in the winter.
- 12. Farms were more isolated. They had to "grow and preserve food." They couldn't depend on the grocery store chain or the mini mart to fill their pantries..
- 13. Learn from the pioneers how to can and dry food.
